A CENTER FOR INCLUSIVE DENTISTRY (CID) IN AUGUSTA CO.

In our community, access to oral care is extremely limited for low-income patients with special healthcare needs (SHCN) (i.e. patients with physical, intellectual, and developmental disabilities, or long-standing medical conditions). The reasons are many: an undertrained dental workforce, a lack of special equipment, etc. As a result, families face long wait times for a dental appointment and then endure long drive times, sometimes as far as Richmond.

NYU DENTISTRY ORAL HEALTH CENTER FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

To provide affordable and dignified care to patients with SHCN in our area, the ARDC joined a pilot program led by the Delta Dental Foundation of Virginia. 4 of our staff members underwent intensive training at New York University and we

purchased specific equipment to treat patients with mobility restrictions and special needs. Our team is determined to welcome 20% more patients with SHCN by the end of 2024 and offer them full range of services directly in our dental home.

Patrick's mom Kim posing with ARDC Dental Assistant Tonya Kim has been bringing her teenage son Patrick to the ARDC since August 2022. "Nobody takes Medicaid no more. It has been very difficult to find a dentist," said Kim. Patrick plays in his high school football team and, according to his mom, has never failed a grade! "It has been wonderful here. I cannot tell you enough how my son is confident with you."

He tends to always want to reschedule medical appointments but not here. After his first appointment he told me, Mom I want to take care of my teeth now," continued Kim. "You guys have had such a wonderful impact. He keeps telling me that even after he is of age and has his own insurance, he wants to find a way to keep coming here".
